The African Continental Free Trade Area and Foreign Direct Investment

This online seminar will discuss the African Continental Free Trade Area and the links with foreign direct investment. Start of trading under AfCFTA began on 1 January 2021 but some negotiations are still to be finalised. In particular, negotiations on the AfCFTA Investment Protocol are due to finish by November 2022.

Trade and investment provisions in AfCFTA have the potential to provide a more stable and attractive policy framework that can attract additional and higher quality investment to Africa. This workshop will discuss which provisions matter for investors and why, with an application to UK FDI in Africa, bearing in mind the overall objective of raising overall investment in Africa that can help to transform African economies. It will also provide country level cases of the possible implication of AfCFTA investment provisions for country level investment framework and the ability to attract more investment based on the work of ODI's Supporting Investment and Trade in Africa Programme.

The seminar will start with a number of high-level remarks, from a variety of perspectives, on the relevance of AfCFTA for attracting more and higher quality investment, followed by a discussion of new analysis on the topic led by Professor Dirk Willem te Velde, and country level reflections (especially Ethiopia and Kenya). The seminar will also include a Q&A moderated by Professor Victor Murinde.
